Course Objectives:

This Course will introduce students to the operation of a 35mm camera. Through lectures, workshops, field trips and critiques, students will learn basic photographic principles plus some black and white darkroom procedures.

- Week 2 Film developing.
- Week 3 Composition Lecture
- Week 4 Critique (exposure workshop); Depth of field calculation.
Field Trip - depth of field workshop. Location T.B.A. Rain or shine.
- Week 5 Darkroom Workshop: Film processing demonstration.
- Week 6 Darkroom workshop: Contact printing and enlarging demonstration.
- Week 7 Darkroom workshop: Enlarging.
- Week 8 Portrait/Motion workshop.
- Week 9 Field Trip - Night photography workshop. Term assignment due.
- Week 10 Final critique; handing back term assignments.
